All pieces will be played by the participants in small groups, accompanied by Basso Continuo.

Raymond Honing studied modern flute as well as baroque flute. He teaches methodology at the Sweelinck Conservatorium of Amsterdam and is founder of the Baroque Ensemble La Barca Leyden.
